



Hepworth Farms is one of Baldor's newest sources for superb quality fruits & vegetables. It's also an organic farm certified by NOFA. Family owned and run by a team of women who are dedicated to providing amazing wholesome products. The farm is located just over an hour north of Baldor's New York warehouse. Since our first introduction to the Hepworth produce in July, their produce has been generating a lot of excitement The Hepworth family farm was established in 1818 and is run today by sisters Amy and Gail Hepworth along with Gerry Greco. The 200 acre farm is based in Milton, New York and is approximately 75 miles north of New York City. Hepworth Farms is a certified organic farm—variable weather patterns in the Northeastern United States, make organic-certified operations somewhat of a rarity in our local farms. A passionate environmentalist, the move to organic certification was championed by Amy Hepworth.

Products from Hepworth Farms



In 1982, Amy took over running the operation from her mother who had been operating the family farm for several years using conventional farming practices. Today, Hepworth is a powerhouse producer of quality organic fruits, vegetables and herbs. The peak of the season runs from June until October, during those months they are harvesting a vast selection of product. The Hepworth's grow over 90 varieties of tomatoes, 60 varieties of peppers and 30 types of eggplant. And then there's corn, kale, cucumbers, lettuces, and more. In total there's over 350 types of produce being grown on the Hepworth's land. Here's what Baldor clients can look forward to this September and October from Hepworth Farms:
